

Not Receiving Texts (Tweets)

You are not signed up properly on twitter. To receive text updates when I tweet (which just means “post” things on the CEliteBaseball twitter account for those of you still using a rock and chisel) you need to do the following:

1. Set up an account on twitter (www.twitter.com). You need an email address for every account you set up, and you need an account for every phone number you want to receive text updates.
2. Link your cell phone to your twitter account (click to edit your profile, and then go to “mobile” - it will have instructions on how to verify your phone)
3. Search “CEliteBaseball” and then click the tab to begin “following” me
4. Once you are following “CEliteBaseball” you need to click on my logo, and then next to the “unfollow” tab you will see a tiny cell phone icon. You need to click this (this step is what tells twitter to send you phone a text message every time I post something on my twitter).

If you have questions please let me know. You can always verify whether you are receiving the texts by going to www.carolinaelitebaseball.com I have a twitter feed on the home page of the website, where you can see if something has been posted recently, and crosscheck it with your phone to see if you received that update.

Note: Once you have setup your twitter account and are following “CEliteBaseball,” you need to look through my followers and locate the other members of your specific CE team. It is mandatory for you to follow the volunteer assistant coaches, as well as the scorekeeper for your specific team (although I recommend you follow everyone on your team). The volunteer assistant coaches, and scorekeepers are the people who update the team on everything specific to that team (I try to avoid “tweeting” things that don’t impact everybody in the program, to avoid unnecessarily clogging up someone’s cell phone with information that doesn’t apply to them). Therefore, if you are not “following” your specific team’s scorekeeper, and assistant coaches you will not be receiving important information for your team!!!
